## Tuition:

- Payments are due upon enrollment. Your spot is not secure until Payment is made. No exceptions.
- Invoices are sent through Brightwheel once enrollment is accepted.

## Makeup Day Policy:

- No makeup days offered for Summer Term when children are sick or by family's choice of absence

- No makeup days offered for weather-related closures during Summer Term
- Makeup days **ARE** offered for June 19, July 4 when scheduled **BEFORE** Summer Term starts. (Juneteenth and Independence Day)
  - Once Summer term starts, makeup days for June 19 and July 4 cannot be schedule

## Pricing for Summer Forest School:

- Enrollment fee \$50
- 1/ day a week: \$220/ four weeks, \$440/ eight weeks
- 2/days a week: \$440/ four weeks, \$880/ eight weeks
- 3/days a week: \$660/ four weeks, \$1320/ eight weeks
- 4/days a week: \$880/ four weeks, \$1760/ eight weeks
- 5/days a week: \$1100/ four weeks, \$2200/ eight weeks
- Drop in Days are not offered during Summer Term
- Makeup Days are not offered during Summer Term

## Withdrawal of Enrollment:

- You can terminate your child's enrollment at any time, however, payments that have already been made cannot be refunded.

## What does this class consist of?

- Class are solely outdoors, led by trained and experienced Teachers (teachers are CPR/First aid certified, background checked, and receive continued training from our Director)
- Child-Led Flow
- Age Appropriate Crafts
- Naturally arising nature lessons, and occasional planned curriculum lessons
- Walks in Nature, climbing and exploring
- Free Play
- Mud Kitchen
- Age Appropriate Building & Fort Making
- Age-Appropriate Storybooks and Nature Literature

- This class does not include: set curriculum, as we believe these ages of children need ample free-play to allow for natural learning and imagination building

## More info:

- Children must be potty trained (we do potty break reminders throughout the day)
- Children are required to bring a backpack with a clean change of clothing (socks, underwear, pants, tshirt.
- Children are required to bring a large lunch-style snack
- Children are required to bring a medium sized Water Bottle (no ice in water during cold months)
- Children should wear clothing they are comfortable to move freely in, that can get dirty, wet, & muddy
- Children are required to wear **long pants** that are durable (jeans/ overalls)
- Children are required to wear hiking boots, or tennis shoes (rain boots not suggested), however, children are encouraged in warm weather to take their shoes off during play to connect into the earth once we arrive to our class spot
- Prompt drop off at 8:30am and pickup at 12:15 is required.
- Groups depart from the drop off spot promptly at 8:45am.
- If families are late for drop off, they are required to walk their children in to meet up with the group. As teachers are guiding class time after they hike in at 8:45, it can be difficult for parents and teachers to coordinate meet up, so please be patient if they aren't immediately responding to a late drop off/meet up.

## Additional Gear for Summer:

- Waterproof Rainsuit, with light clothing underneath and a light sweatshirt, on days when **rain is in the forecast** the ground is significantly wet and muddy
- Waterproof Shoes when rain is in the forecast
- Jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts for the cooler mornings
- Sun hats
- Please apply sunscreen and/or bug spray prior to class time, if you desire
