Tuition and Makeup Policies:

- Payments are due upon enrollment. Your spot is not secure until Payment is made.
- Invoices are sent through Brightwheel once enrollment information is received.
- No makeup days or credits offered for days absent.
- Limited makeup days offered for weather cancellations.
- Makeup days for weather closures may be offered on days other than the class' regular scheduled time.
- Makeup days can be scheduled for a different class time and/or location than you normally attend for weather cancellations.
- Makeup days expire at the end of each seasonal session, and do not carry over into future sessions

Withdrawal policy:

You can terminate your child's enrollment at anytime, however, payments that have already been made cannot be refunded.

More info:

- Please bring snacks for you and your children, and water bottles
- Parents are welcome to wear baby carriers, or packs to carry young children, however, we encourage any children of walking abilities to walk along with us
- Parents and children both should plan to wear clothing they are comfortable in, and clothing that can get dirty, wet, & muddy
- Children are required to wear long pants that are durable (jeans/ overalls)
- Children are required to wear hiking boots, or tennis shoes, however, parents and children are encouraged in warm weather to take their shoes off during play to connect into the earth once we walk to our class "camp spot"

- It is recommended that parents bring a clean change of clothes and shoes for their children to change into after class, we encourage children to play freely and this included getting muddy, wet, and dirty

Additional Gear Required/Suggested for year-round outdoor time:

- Waterproof snowsuits, waterproof snow boots, waterproof gloves, warm hats, wool socks, wool base layers, wool or fleece mid layer
- Waterproof Rainsuit
- Jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts
- Sun hats, and sunscreen and/or bug spray as parents desire
